

## British Triathlon Technical Official Expenses Policy

From 1st January 2012 the rate of expenses that can be charged by Technical Officials is as follows:

### **Children's Events**

An event restricted to TriStars and/or Youth age groups only:

- Technical Officials - £40 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles
- Motorcycle Officials - £50 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles

### **Community Event**

An event organised on a 'not for profit' basis:

- Technical Officials - £40 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles
- Motorcycle Officials - £50 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles

### **Commercial Event**

An event organised on a 'for profit' basis:

- Chief Technical Official - £60 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles
- Assistant Technical Officials - £50 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles
- Motorcycle Officials - £50 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles

### **National Event**

An event designated as a Home Nation National Championships or an ITU/ETU qualifier where the extent of duties is greater than other events:

- Chief Technical Official - £70 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles
- Assistant Technical Officials - £50 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles
- Motorcycle Officials - £50 for the event + 40p per mile for additional mileage over 100 miles

### Guidance Notes

Expenses are to be claimed direct from the Event Organiser.

Mileage should include all pre-event travel (course recces etc) where agreed beforehand with the Event Organiser. Motorcycle Officials mileage should also include pre-event course recce and mileage accrued during the event.

All Technical Officials continue to be responsible for ensuring they declare any individual income that is not an expense from officiating at triathlon events to HMRC, to remain compliant with current regulations.
