UK Coaching Awards

The UK Coaching Awards honour sports coaches and coaching organisations who have demonstrated outstanding success over the previous 12 months.

Awards are made following a public nominations process and decision by an expert judging panel. There are eight award categories for coaches and three for awards in support of coaching, plus the overall title of UK Coach of the Year. That means there's a category for every aspect of coaching, from those volunteers working at a local level in the community right through to coaches working with our national teams. Please note that some categories are restricted to nominations for volunteer coaches.

In line with our long-term objective of having a more diverse coaching workforce, we're particularly keen to receive nominations on behalf of women coaches together with coaches from a BME background.

This year's event will be held at the Midland Hotel in Manchester on the evening of 1 December. One of the highlights of the evening will be the presentation of the Coaching Chain, which recognises the contribution of a group of coaches throughout the development of an elite athlete.
