Type 1: Aluminium scaffolding with the key clamp system, 4.8m lengths (for 10 bikes) with a custom welded bracket at 60degrees and two legs at each join. £10 per length + £10 per leg set, enough for 300-400 bikes.

Type 2: Galvanised steel A frame racking £20 per A Frame, enough for 600 bikes.
